Mission Focus

Colombia, once a colony of Spain, gained its independence as a separate state from what had been known as Gran Colombia (Colombia, Ecuador, and Venezuela) in 1831. Colombia struggled under decades of conflict between government forces, paramilitaries, and anti-government insurgent groups heavily funded by the drug trade. However, in 2016, the Colombian government signed a final peace accord, ratified by the Colombian Congress, that called for members of these groups to demobilize, disarm, and reincorporate into society and politics. The Church of the Nazarene began its work there in 1975, and former South America Regional Director Dr. Christian Sarmiento (not the 45th General Superintendent) was instrumental in that endeavor. Pray for revival, a spiritual awakening in the 89 organized churches in Colombia, and for new pastors.
