Mission Focus

Located just off the southern tip of Malaysia, the city nation of *Singapore* is a travel hub for Asia, a gateway to areas where the Church of the Nazarene is not yet established. Often referred to as a "Vertical Village," 6 million people live on an island approximately 26 miles long and 14 miles wide. It is the third highest population density nation in the world. Within a radius of seven hours flight time from Singapore are 30 countries, 3 billion people, and 900 people groups unreached by the gospel of Jesus Christ. The Church of the Nazarene officially registered in Singapore in 2016 and has sought to find a meaningful place in this nation of "religious harmony". In order to maintain "religious harmony" laws that govern religion, its practices, and its expansion, some conventional evangelism and church planting strategies are not allowed. Pray for the only fully organized Nazarene church in Singapore as it develops a children's Sunday school program and pursues outreach ministry among foreign workers.
