

SWID Nazarene Disaster Response to Hurricane Helene.

Our Nazarene Disaster Response ministry has contacted several district superintendents (DS) in the region and while several churches close to the disaster are already serving and supporting the initial response, there has not been a call put out for teams by Nazarene Compassionate Ministries at this moment due to search and rescue, road closures, etc., but that may change in the coming weeks.

So, what can we do now?

- 1. PRAY. First and most important, you can pray. Pray for those who have suffered unimaginable loss and are without many of the basic necessities for everyday living. Pray for the restoration of utilities, roads, health care services and other basic needs. Pray for protection for those who have been displaced and those who are providing relief. Pray that those providing relief will demonstrate the love and compassion of Jesus in all that they do. Pray that those suffering will be open to hearing the Gospel in spite of their overwhelming circumstances.
- 2. GIVE to SWID Disaster Response efforts. We are currently working with a DS in North Carolina to get supplies to the area. We plan on taking bottled water and flood buckets very soon and will likely make additional trips in the near future. Donations to SWID Disaster Response will be used to purchase bottled water and additional supplies for SWID response efforts. 5. VOLUNTEER. You can volunteer your time and talents. If you have access to a box truck and are willing to drive supplies to the relief area, please contact the SWID district office. Or, you can volunteer to be on a NCM Disaster Response Volunteer team and assist when called upon. We are, however, several weeks from organizing teams to deploy to the area.
