## Church of the Nazarene Manual (127b)

"We direct our local churches to elect as church officers active members of the local church who profess the experience of entire sanctification and whose lives bear public witness to the grace of God that calls us to a holy life; who are in harmony with the doctrines, polity, and practices of the Church of the Nazarene; and who support the local church faithfully in attendance, active service, and with tithes and offerings. Church officers should be fully engaged in 'making Christ-like disciples in the nations.'"

It is expected that board members of the Mackey Church of the Nazarene...

- be born-again Christians.
- be sanctified wholly (received the baptism of the Holy Spirit).
- be in harmony with the doctrine, polity, & practices of the Church of the Nazarene.
- faithfully support the church through attendance (more than once a week and include revivals and other special services).
- faithfully support the church through the Lord's tithe and our offerings.
- faithfully support the church through active service (some form of local church ministry).
- seek to bear with one another, maintain unity in the Spirit of God, and edify the work of God at Mackey Church of the Nazarene.
- be supportive of the church & other leadership (no negative comments on social media, biblical conflict resolution is essential, etc).

As board members, you are visible leaders of the local church and therefore must be models of Christ-like living. Your faith must be worthy of imitation.
